IFB Title/Number: KRT2025-FUEL

The following questions were submitted in relation to the solicitation referenced above. Responses will be provided by KRT and issued to all prospective bidders.

1. Q: Gallons locked in will be used and any gallons purchased above the locked in gallons would then be priced on the fluctuating OPIS option?

A: Yes, any gallons purchased beyond the locked in amount would then be priced on the fluctuating OPIS pricing.

2. Q: To confirm, the +/- 10% clause is only when you are deciding how many gallons to lock in from what is stated in the bid? Everything locked in then is what is guaranteed to be used?

A: The gallon quantities stated in the IFB for each product (e.g., 690,000 gallons of E10 and 390,000 gallons of ULSD) are good-faith estimates and serve as the base amounts for the contract, with a plus or minus ten percent ($\pm 10\%$) range. They are used for bidding, evaluation, and planning purposes.

The $\pm 10\%$ is not limited only to an initial "lock-in" decision. Rather, it reflects that actual usage over the life of the contract may be up to approximately 10% higher or lower than the stated base amount for each fuel type. Actual gallons ordered will depend on operational needs.
